The lung is within normal limits.</p> <p>Right lateral view abdomen: Patient appears thin but adequately fleshed. Small amount of residual ingesta and blurred rugal fold margination is seen for the stomach. No overt segmental luminal dilation or mural plication is seen for the small bowel. Semiformed stool is seen for the colon.</p> <p>Conclusion Dehydration/hypovolemia vs. electrolyte imbalance. GI tract ddx: nonspecific gastritis potentially merging to gastroenteritis (viral, dietary indiscretion), pancreatitis, emergent infiltrative mural disease, partial obstruction.</p> <p>Recommendations (The caudal most abdomen is excluded from the lateral view submitted.) Summary:

Dog Neuter: Endotracheal tube placed, cuff inflated, maintained with Isoflurane and oxygen. Prescrotal area clipped and prepped with Chlorhexidine scrub. Spermatic cord local block with 1mg/kg bupivacaine. Pre-scrotal incision; closed castration performed with spermatic cord double ligated using absorbable monofilament suture. Closure in two layers with absorbable monofilament suture. Tattoo applied. E. Tube pulled following return of swallowing reflex. Recovery from anesthesia uneventful.
